

## \*\*\* **State of Illinois Requirement** \*\*\*

The Illinois Secretary of State requires that students enrolled in a driver education program show proof that they are in good standing with their high school. To show proof, a signed *Driver Education Verification* Form is required \*OR\* grades (you do not have to submit both). Either document must be submitted on the first classroom session.

### **Driver Education Verification Form**

- The Driver Education Verification Form must be signed by
  - student
  - parent
  - high school administrator
- Home schooled students we will provide the Home School Parental Consent Form (ask your Top Driver instructor for the form)

### **Grades**

- Grades must include the following preprinted information
  - Student name
  - School name
  - School year or date (not print date)
  - Two current semesters showing at least eight (8) passing grades

To avoid delays in certificate of completion processing, which is required to take the driver's license test, students must submit the Driver Education Verification Form *on or before the first class*.
