



How to Evaluate a Driving School

- Ask questions of the school:
 - What is their teaching approach?
 - What techniques do they employ in the class and in the vehicle?
 - Are classes lecture-based or interactive?
 - Do they rely on (old) videos?
- Visit a class
 - Are the students engaged or are they bored and almost asleep?
 - Does the classroom encourage interactive learning?
 - Is the classroom modern and inviting or drab?
- Ask friends and neighbors – were their teens engaged and did they learn safe driving skills or did they pass through and get a license?
- Do they provide tools and resources for parents:
 - Training for parents?
 - Ongoing assessments and feedback on your teen's progress?
 - Tools to help you manage the process?
- Do they have a web site? If yes, is it contemporary and useful?
